You <u>MUST</u> bring:

- Case for transporting pistols and revolvers to and from firing line
- Empty Chamber flag

Sign in starts at 6:00 pm Shooters meeting 6:20 pm Shooting begins at 6:30 pm Shooting ends around 9:00 pm

<u>RULES</u>

Match director will appoint a Range Safety Officer (RSO) to the shooting port. It is the match director's discretion to select port RSO.

- 1) <u>Firearms</u> are to remain <u>unloaded and bagged or holstered</u> until shooter is in the port and given the load and make ready command by the RSO.
- 2) Muzzle of the gun is to remain down range at all times.
- 3) Shooter's finger is to remain off the trigger until shooter is on target.
- 4) Shooters are expected to have loaded magazines and speed loaders before being called to the line.
- 5) Starting position is low ready and finger is off the trigger.
- 6) Each time shooter steps into the port to shoot they will be limited to:
 - A maximum of 20 rounds.
 - A maximum of 2 plate rack setups.
 - A maximum of 3 minutes.

7) When you are in the port to shoot:

- a) DO NOT unbag/unholster firearm until RSO gives you command to do so.
- b) RSO will give the load and make ready command.
- c) RSO will give command to begin shooting.
- d) When shooting is finished: Drop magazine, show clear chamber or cylinder (RSO and shooter <u>both</u> verify chamber is clear), insert flag and slide forward.
- e) Bag or holster firearm. At this time the shooter is able to leave the line.
- 8) Shooter goes to "back of line" to shoot again.
- 9) There will be one designated non-shooting port for shooters to handle firearms. If you intend to handle your firearm in this port you <u>MUST</u> notify the RSO. OTHERWISE THIS PORT IS TO REMAIN EMPTY. THERE IS ABSOLUTELY <u>NO AMMO ALLOWED</u> IN THIS PORT. LEAVE YOUR LOADED MAGS BEHIND.

RSO has final decision on safety matters! Do not argue! SAFETY IS EVERYONES JOB!
